

GPoT Center Submission Guidelines

GPoT Center welcomes contributions for its publications, covering a broad range of issues concerning not only Turkish foreign policy but also the current international agenda.

Types of Submissions

GPoT Center publishes the following types of publications:

1. **Policy Briefs** that include insightful analysis by global experts of a wide range of issues in international relations.
2. **Policy Updates** that provide a general background to and overview of the latest developments on a specific topic in international relations.
3. **GPoT Briefs** that provide profound analyses of "hot topics" on the global agenda.

Manuscript Style

1. All submissions must be sent as a Microsoft Word or Open Office file.
2. We accept contributions whether in English or Turkish.
3. Length: Policy Briefs should not exceed 10 pages, policy updates should be no longer than 5 pages, and GPoT Briefs should range between 6 and 7 pages.
4. Reference style: GPoT Center adheres to the APA style. All submitted manuscripts are expected to fully conform to this style. For the guidelines on APA, please visit <http://goo.gl/UTp1q>
5. Footnotes should be used only to provide additional information about the content to the readers. A complete list of references in alphabetical order should be included at the end of the article.
6. All contributions should include the following components:
 - a) Title of the article
 - b) The name of the author
 - c) A short biography
 - d) Abstract with no more than 250 words
 - e) Author's contact details (an e-mail address)

Manuscript Submission

GPoT Center publishes only original contributions that have not been published before and/or that are not currently under revision of another publisher. All submitted contributions are expected to be objective and strictly in line with academic standards.

Each submitted article is peer-reviewed by GPoT Center editorial board. Editors reserve the right to make linguistic and/or stylistic changes if necessary. GPoT Center remunerates author if the article is published as a compensation for copyright transfer.

Authors should send their contributions to info@gpotcenter.org with the subject of the e-mail reading as "Article submission". All submissions should be saved under the following file name: "NameSurname_Year", e.g. Jane Smith submitting an article in 2012: "JaneSmith_2012".

Please note that submissions that neglect these guidelines will be sent back to the author for revision.
